 - b) in the case of the data of a recommended person - for the purpose of conducting and adjudicating in the Young Poland Program Competition pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR;

- 4) the recipients of personal data contained in this recommendation form will be entities providing service of administrators' IT systems and software, external entities providing services to administrators, and entities authorized to obtain personal data on the basis of law regulations (including public administration bodies);
- 5) the data subject has the right to request the administrators to provide access to personal data, to correct them, delete or limit their processing, in cases specified in the provisions of the GDPR;
- 6) personal data will be processed:
 - a) in the case of recommendations issued to people applying for the Young Poland Program Competition - throughout the entire period of implementation of activities related to the conduct and settlement of the Young Poland Program Competition, and after its completion for the purpose of compulsory archiving on the terms set out in separate regulations,
